WERKE DER ACHTSAMKEIT WORKS OF MINDFULNESS OBRAS SOBRE LA CONCIENTIZACIÓN

The project WORKS OF MINDFULNESS is about a careful encounter with natural abundance. I work locally with what the environment has to offer, making the work site-specific by depicting the flora (and sometimes fauna) of the region I work in. With the available natural material I create objects - taking the seeds and thorns of plants, petals of flowers or whatever other material is at hand and putting it in a new context.

An important part in this play available plants of all kind, which I use to make SELFMADE YARN AND ROPE FROM PLANT-FIBRES.

It is a re-arrangement of the existing beauty, but the new frame gives the observer a different perspective and thus possibility to (re)connect to nature on another level.

Frequently after exhibitions locals approach me to state that they are being inspired to walk through their world with open eyes again – the "unspectacular" everyday surrounding has transformed into something magical again.

The project pleads for the natural beauty and wants to open a space of contemplation and wonder while at the same time not creating harm to the spaces I initially want to promote.

CONNECT

CONNECT plays with the topic of connectivity and the strength of the individual / the collective, as well as the (s)pace and percipience of time.

Fracturable and apparently rather insignificant individual elements, in this case individual blades of grass, are interwoven into a rope and thus become important and resilient components of a durable whole. The selfmade plant-rope is being installed throughout the space.

The fact of "relating" is reinforced by the durational performance: For several hours (usually three hours) the artist is devotedly and slowly adding blade of grass after blade of grass, thus expanding the field and effect, while opening a space of contemplation, presence and being.




All plastic is being taken from the waste bin All natural components are being carefully collected in nature













MIND YOUR TRACE


This installation has been created entirely of trash found on the riverside (in Wonju, South Korea). Opening a space to reflect upon our contribution to environmental pollution and reminding us of the responsibility that we, as co-inhabitants of this planet, have to take care of this our home. We are not only harming the planet but ultimately ourselves. We are part of the cycle that is nature and this knowledge can and should guide us in our actions.

The installation creates a soundscape (plastic and tin touching and clashing), by the visitors passing by and thus moving the air, and by using a fan.









ENTDECKE DEIN LICHT

"Entdecke dein licht" is an immersive theatrical performance, in which the audience is invited to experience LIGHT and the process of BREATHING in a conscious way. After a short debriefing at the beginning of the piece between the artists and the audience, in which we present the benefits of conscious breathing, we submerge into a 30 minutes long journey through different spaces were we re-discover LIGHT and adapt our point of view towards the world around us with a whole new perspective. Each different room is designed in a different way, making emphasis on the distinct aspects of Light as a medium, an experience, and as time-space itself, and we recall during our journey the positive aspects of breathing in order to remain calm and in control.

"Entdecke dein Licht" is a flexible format in which its configuration, duration and target audience is adapted to each circumstance. We design the space having into consideration the possibilities of each room and we adapt our timing and our story to this new environment. We also modify the way the story is being told, according to the presence of adults or children in the audience, and we have at disposal a wide range of Light experiments that we use to fulfil the needs of our narrative.

LUSUS NATURAE NATURSPIEL



It is a play with light, colours and forms and although it happens in a (small) plastic tent, it connects us with (the vastness of) nature on a deep and beautiful level.

the answers are often: home / belonging / amazing / relaxed / rejuvenated




Annotation:

ENTROPY

A project about human perception and cognition.
Based on Radical Constructivism, an inspiring position of
Epistemology, and the psychology of perception
I propose the following questions:

- _When and from which point on is chaos, or as the case may, order/harmony, being perceived?
- _How much information is needed for this, and how does it need to be arranged?
- _Can chaos, in the sense of a complete jumble of unrelated impulses, ever be perceived?

Basically the entire stimulus-range is completely chaotic and is structured and being put into a meaningful order IN THE ACT of perceiving. Since perception in itself is an assortative process, can chaos only be a thought and is therefore completely abstract?

Last but not least I am fascinated by the fact that the same field of stimulus generates the most diverse perceptions and interpretations and it is this diversity and abundance that I seek to discover, reveal and explore.

Along with a deeper understanding in the sciences, emerged what is probably the most important law of physics for understanding the evolution of the universe and the passage of time. It's called the 2nd law of thermodynamics.

The reason the 2nd law of thermodynamics was so profound was because at its heart it contained a radically new concept, sth. physicists call Entropy.

Entropy explains why, left to the mercy of the elements, mortar crumples, glass shatters and buildings collapse.



BLUTBILDER A LOVE DECLARATION TOWARDS THE FEMALE MENSTRUAL CYCLE

The period as a life-giving, multifaceted and everyday-life experience.

The private space of the bathroom is being left behind in order to manifest an adequate, open and natural attitude towards the female menstrual cycle.

Taboo, shame, embarrassment and lack of knowledge stand in contrast to the wonderful process that every woman experiences around 500 times in her lifetime and which allows our unique human existence in the first place.

There is so much taboo around this, that still today the "blood" in the ads for female sanitary products is being shown as blue. This states clearly the lack of connection we have with this natural process.

This fundamental and basic issue deserves a mature and appreciative approach from us, in contrast to the period-shaming that most of us experience. Ongoing process, since 2014.

Additionally further issues such as waste production and environmental harm related to the usage of female hygienic products are being adressed.
